



PILGRIMAGE TO ITALY AND POLAND JUNE 17 – JUNE 30, 2019



Dear Pilgrims,

If ever there was a time to make a pilgrimage to the Eternal City and Poland – Land of Mercy, it is now, during the Year of the 40th Anniversary of the election of Cardinal Karol Wojtyła as Pope John Paul II. Please join us. A Pilgrimage is a special time to meet God and to prepare ourselves for our journey to heaven. During our Pilgrimage you will participate on Daily Mass, touch holy places and meet people who are witnesses of the Gospel.

Day 01: Departure – June 17

Departure from your gateway city, transatlantic flight to **Rome**

Day 2: Arrival. Accommodation in Hotel or Convent. Free Time - June 18

Day 3 - Rome - Papal Audience - June 19

This morning we go to Vatican City to attend a special Papal Audience and Blessing given by His Holiness, Pope Francis. After lunch we will enjoy a five hours panoramic city tour viewing the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, and the Monument of Victor Emmanuel in Piazza Venezia. We will visit the Basilica of Saint John Lateran, Santa Maria Maggiore and Saint Paul. Free Time. Overnight in Rome

Day 4- Rome - June 20

Holy Mass in Saint Peter Basilica. After our visit to Saint Peter Basilica, we will visit the Vatican Museum. After Lunch, we will take a guided walking tour. Discover churches showing how art, faith and culture have been integrated over the centuries in Italy. Walking tour: Piazza Navona, Pantheon, Trevi Fountain, and Spanish Steps. Free Time. Overnight in Rome

Day 5 – Rome – Manoppello – Lanciano – San Giovanni Rotondo - June 21

Very early we will live to Lanciano via Manoppello. Manoppello is the Sanctuary of Miraculous Face of Jesus Christ - an image on a thin byssus veil, a sudarium, known as the Holy Face of Manoppello and which has been reputed to be identical to the Veil of Veronica and is considered to be the burial cloth, forming a whole with the Shroud of Turin. We will continue to Lanciano, where we will visit the Church of St. Longinus where we will see the Eucharistic Miracle and celebrate Mass. The Basilian hieromonk had doubts about the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. With doubt in his voice, he said the "Words of Consecration" and the bread turned into living flesh, and the wine changed into live blood. Overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo

Day 6 - San Giovanni Rotondo – Gargano - June 22

San Giovanni Rotondo, the place of Saint Padre Pio. After celebrating Mass at the tomb of Padre Pio, we tour the sanctuary, see the old church and the crucifix from which he received the stigmata in 1918. We will have the opportunity to view and pray before the incorrupt body of **Padre Pio**. After Lunch we will take a short pilgrimage to The Sanctuary of Monte Sant Angelo sul Gargano, sometimes called simply Monte Gargano, is a Catholic sanctuary on Mount Gargano, Italy, part of the commune of Monte Sant Angelo. It is the oldest shrine in Western Europe dedicated to the Archangel Michael and has been an important pilgrimage site since the Middle Ages. Overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo

Day 7 - San Giovanni Rotondo – Rome - June 23

After Breakfast departure to Rome. On our way we will stop in Pietrelcina – Birthplace of Saint Padre Pio. Overnight in Rome

DAY 8 – Rome – Krakow - June 24

After Breakfast transfer to Airport. Departure to Krakow, Poland
Arrival to Krakow. Transfer to Hotel. Overnight in Krakow

Day 9 - Krakow-Lagiewnik - June 25

Full Day in the World Sanctuary of Divine Mercy, consecrated by John Paul II in 2002. Here Sister Faustina lived and died. Prayer at the tomb of Saint Faustina. Overnight in Krakow

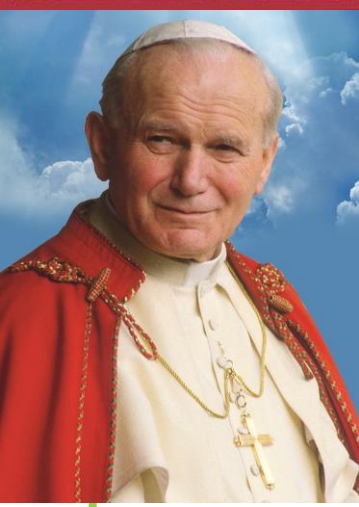

Day 10 - Krakow- Wieliczka - June 26

After morning Mass a guided tour in one of Poland's most important religious cities. You'll start your tour in the Old Town area with its Market Square which is considered one of the largest squares in Europe. After brief lunch, tour to Wieliczka – oldest Salt Mine in Europe. Overnight in Krakow

Day 11 - Krakow- Czestochowa - June 27

After Breakfast Departure to Czestochowa. On our way we will stop in Wadowice – Birthplace of Saint John Paul II. Overnight in Czestochowa

Day 12 – Czestochowa - All day with our Most Blessed Mother - June 28

Czestochowa, the most holy place for the Polish people. There, we will see the famous Black Madonna, which is believed to have been brought to Czestochowa from Jerusalem on August 31, 1382. The city of Czestochowa is the principal center of the Catholic religion in Poland for the last 600 years. Take some time to explore on your own before dinner. Overnight in Czestochowa

Day 13 – Czestochowa – Niepokalanow - Warsaw- June 29

After Breakfast departure to Niepokalanow – City of Immaculate and Fr. Maximilian Maria Kolbe. **Niepokalanów** (*City of the Immaculate*) is a Catholic religious community near Warsaw, founded in 1927 by Franciscan Friar Maximilian Kolbe. After Lunch Departure to Warsaw – capital of Poland. We will visit the Old Town, including King's Palace, Churches from 14th and 15th Century and Warsaw Ghetto. Holy Mass and prayers in the Convent of the Sister of Our Lady of Mercy, where Saint Faustina began her monastic life in 1924. Overnight in Warsaw

Day 14 – Departure to USA - June 30
