Day: October 18 – USA – SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Tour members meet for our departing flight via wide-bodied aircraft, arriving next morning in Santiago de Compostela. Meals served on board.

Day 2: October 19 –SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Arrival to Santiago de Compostela. Transfer to Hotel. Overnight in Santiago.

Day 3: October 20 –SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Shrine of Saint James the Great

The city has its origin in the shrine of Saint James the Great, now the city's cathedral, as destination of the Way of St. James, a leading Catholic pilgrimage route originated in the 9th century. In 1985 the city's Old Town was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Sightseeing and religious activities in Santiago de Compostela. Overnight in Santiago de Compostela

Day 4: October 21 - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA - FATIMA

After Breakfast Departure to Fatima. After dinner we will participate in the Candlelight Procession Overnight in Fatima.

Day 5: October 22 – FATIMA

Sanctuary of our Lady in Fatima

Today will surely be a memorable experience as you pray and meditate upon one of Our Blessed Mother's apparition sites. Our Lady appeared to three shepherd children; Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco. Morning sightseeing tour with a local guide of Fatima where in 1917 Mary appeared to local children and the "miracle of the sun" occurred. We will celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Apparition and visit the House of Lucia, House of Francisco and Jacinta. The afternoon is free to pray, reflect and relax. After dinner we will participate in the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Fatima.

Day 6: October 23 - FATIMA - SALAMANCA

After Breakfast departure to Salamanca. Its Old City was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1988. We will visit the Cathedral Nueva – Cathedral Vieja in Salamanca. Overnight in Salamanca.

Day 7: October 24 – SALAMANCA - AVILLA – MADRID

Sanctuary – Birthplace of Saint Teresa of Avilla

Morning we will depart to Avila and Salamanca. Avilla - The best-preserved walled city in the world and home of St. Teresa of Avila who, with her spiritual son St. John of the Cross, reformed the Carmelite Order. We visit the Carmelite Monastery and celebrate Mass there. We will visit the cell where St. Teresa lived and see relics of Teresa and St. John of the Cross. We'll also tour the ancient city of Avila whose architecture and culture remain the same from centuries ago. Overnight in Madrid.

Day 8: October 25 – MADRID

Sanctuary of our Lady of Almudena in Madrid

This morning, you will awaken in the capital city of Spain! Following Holy Mass in the Cathedral Church, where we will venerate the Miracle Statue of Our Lady of Almudena, patroness of Madrid. After Mass we will enjoy a tour of Madrid that includes the Royal Palace and the *Plaza Mayor*. Both sites are iconic to Madrid as the Palace holds state ceremonies and events; and the *Plaza Mayor* is the geographic center of Madrid, as well as the social center. Overnight in Madrid.

Day 9: October 26 – MADRID – ZARAGOZA - BARCELONA

Sanctuary of our Lady of Pilar in Zaragoza

We will depart from Madrid to Zaragoza and we will visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, where we will celebrate Mass. It is here that Mary appeared to the Apostle James before her Assumption into heaven. Evening arrival to Barcelona. Overnight in Barcelona.

Day 10: October 27 - BARCELONA – MONTSERRAT

Sanctuary of our Lady in Montserrat

This morning we will visit Barcelona – one of the most beautiful city in Europe. Visit the Cathedral Church SAGRADA FAMILIA. At noon we depart from Barcelona to Montserrat the spectacular mountain Sanctuary of our Lady of Montserrat. Day 11: October 28 – BARCELONA – LOURDES

Day 12: October 29 – LOURDES

Sanctuary of our Lady in Lourdes

Morning sightseeing to Lourdes where in 1858 Mary appeared to a young Bernadette Soubirous. We will celebrate Mass at the basilica. We will visit the sites of Lourdes including

the Grotto, the spring and the healing Baths, as well as the Basilica of St. Pius X, the Rosary Basilica and Bernadette's home. The afternoon is free for Adoration, Confessions, a time of private devotion, reciting the Rosary, and relaxation before dinner. Dinner. Following dinner, we join the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Lourdes

Day 13: October 30 – LOURDES - ARS-sur-Forman's

Continue our journey to ARS. There is a tomb of the Holy priest St. Jean Baptiste Marie (May 8, 1786 - August 4, 1859) He was a French parish priest who became a saint and the patron saint of parish priests. He is often referred to as the "Curé d'Ars" (the parish priest of the village of Ars). Overnight in Ars.

Day 14: November 31 - ARS-sur-Forman's – Nevers - PARIS

Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal

Morning departure to Nevers - Visit the incorrupt body of St. Bernadette. Holy Mass.

Continue our journey to Paris. After arrival we will visit the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal. Here the Blessed Virgin spoke to St. Catherine Laboure. Overnight in Paris.

Day 15 November 01 – PARIS

Holy Mass in the La Basilique du Sacré Cœur de Montmartre. After Holy Mass we will Notre Dame Cathedral and more. For a bird's eye view take the elevator to the second floor of Paris' most famous landmark, the EIFFEL TOWER. Afternoon we will visit: Arc de Triomphe, and Champs-Élysées. Free Time. Overnight in Paris.

Day 16 November 02 – PARIS – USA

After Breakfast – Holy Mass. Free Time. Diner and overnight in Paris.
